Paying for a loved one's funeral

If a family member has recently passed away, here are some places to contact to get help with their funeral costs.

Services Australia

If you've lost a partner who received a Centrelink benefit, you may be able to access a bereavement payment. Contact Services Australia's Indigenous Call Centre on **1800 136 380**.

Superannuation funds

Check if the person who passed away had insurance as part of their superannuation. Look at any superannuation paperwork for who to call. If there is no paperwork, call the ATO's Indigenous Helpline on 13 10 30.

If the person who passed away was dependent on you, you may be able to access your superannuation early to cover the costs of their funeral. Talk to your super fund.

Department of Veteran's Affairs

Veterans or former members of the Australian Defence Force may be able to get help with funeral costs. Call an Indigenous Veterans' Liaison Officer on 1300 551 918.

Organisations that can help with funeral costs

Contact your local Aboriginal Corporation or Native Title Body Corporate to see if they can help you to pay for the funeral.
